Submitting images:

In the first instance please email 10 low resolution jpegs (1024px on the longest side) to ben.andrew@rspb.org.uk and make the subject of your email

'New photographer submission: (Your Name)'

Please answer the following questions in the body of the email:

1. How many images do you have in your archive?
2. What photographic equipment do you use?
3. What would you consider your specialist area of photography to be?
4. Are you currently represented by any other photographic libraries?

Please ensure the total size of your initial email of low-res images is under 5MB.

You will receive a response within 2-4 weeks, but due to the high volume of prospective submissions, we regret that we are unable to comment in detail on individual submissions.

If we think your work may be suitable for our collection you will be asked to submit a further 100 low-resolution images, processed to our specifications for consideration by our selection team. Those photographers who are selected for representation by RSPB Images will be offered a contract and will be invited to submit images on a bi-monthly basis.

Technical Specifications:

Should you be successful in your application you must be able to supply high-resolution files to the following specifications:

- JPEG files saved at maximum quality
- 300ppi
- Images should be a minimum of 25mb in size uncompressed
- Colour space - Adobe RGB (1998)
- Files should be 8 bit
- Images should be cleaned at 100%
- Images should be colour corrected
- Files should be titled as follows: Common name Latin name, a brief description about what is happening in the image, the location, month. Please also include any information regarding captive animals or composite images.
- Images can only be sharpened at the RAW stage - Minimal sharpening only
- Images can be sent via a clearly labelled CD/DVD with your name, they can also be sent via file sharing software such as WeTransfer, Dropbox etc
